Forms and Conditions of Foreign Liquor Licences

THE Governor has, under section 24 of "The Excise Ordinance, No. 8 of 1911" directed that on and after October 1, 1931, licences for the manufacture of malt liquor and for carrying out any business in foreign liquor shall be granted—

- (a) on payment of the fees shown in Schedule I;
- (b) for a period of not more than one year;
- (c) in the forms given in Schedule II;
- (d) and subject to the restrictions and on the conditions contained in the said forms.

Excise Notification No. 76 published in the Government Gazette No. 6,953 of June 28, 1918, Excise Notification No. 141 published in the Government Gazette No. 7,390 of May 2, 1924, and Excise Notification No. 173 published in Government Gazette No. 7,642 of May 11, 1928, are hereby rescinded.

SCHEDULE I

Vide Unamended Schedule

Note.—For the purposes of assessment of the fees prescribed in this schedule, one "spirit gallon" shall be deemed to be equivalent to—

One gallon whiskey, or 1 gallon brandy, or 1 gallon gin, or 1 gallon rum, or 3 gallons malt liquor, or 3 gallons wine.

Kind of Licences	Fees to be charged
1. Licence to manufacture malt liquor	Rs. 50
IA. Licence to manufacture country made "foreign" spirits ..	Rs. 250 for the 12 months ending September 30, or Rs. 125 for any period after April 1 ending September 30, in any year.
IB. Licence to manufacture, bottle, and sell milk punch ..	Rs. 10 for the 12 months ending September 30, in any year or for any shorter period. (E. N. No. 296.)
IC. Licence to manufacture country made "foreign" spirits from spirits distilled from the coconut or any of its products other than toddy	Rs. 500 for the 12 months ending September 30, or Rs. 250 for any period after April 1 ending September 30 in any year. (E. N. No. 314.)

3. Wholesale licence ..	Rs. 250 in Colombo and Rs. 200 outside Colombo
4. Retail licence ..	50 cents per spirit gallon of estimated consumption, subject to a minimum of Rs. 200 in Municipal towns and Rs. 100 elsewhere.
5. Tavern Licences.—All tavern licences will be sold by tender or auction for the licensing period 1936-37 and thereafter. (As amended by E. N. No. 258.)	
Kind of Licences	Fees to be charged
6. Beer and Porter licence ..	50 cents per spirit gallon of estimated consumption. (Subject to a minimum of Rs. 30 E. N. No. 282.)
6A. Beer and Porter licence for the sale of locally manufactured malt liquor only ..	Rs. 30. (As amended by E. N. No. 241.)
7. Hotel licence ..	Rs. 1 per spirit gallon of estimated consumption subject to a minimum fee of Rs. 100.
8. Hotel bar licence ..	Rs. 1 per spirit gallon of estimated consumption subject to a minimum fee of Rs. 200 in Municipal towns and Rs. 100 elsewhere.
