Procurement of Design, Develop, Implementation & Maintenance of Revenue Administration System for Excise Department (RASED)

- The Chairman, Standing High Level Procurement Committee on behalf of the Excise Department of Sri Lanka (EDSL) invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Procurement of Design, Develop, Implementation and Maintenance of Revenue Administration System for Excise Department. The implementation period for design, develop and implementation is Two (2) years and Support and Maintenance period is Four (4) years.
- 2. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB- Two Envelope System: Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding Procedure) method specified in the Procurement Guidelines 2024 on Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services, and are opened to all eligible bidders as defined in the Guidelines

Bidders must meet the following minimum qualification criteria for the contract award:

a) **General Experience:** Bidder should have general experience in Information

To be eligible for contract award, the successful bidder should not be blacklisted.

- Technology Contracts in the role of contractor, subcontractor or management contractor at least Five (5) years prior to the bid submission deadline;
- b) Specific Experience:
 - i. Bidder should have successfully completed at least one (1) Software Application Development/ Customization project with a value of at least LKR 100 million within the last 5 years prior to the bid submission deadline.
 - ii. Bidder should have successfully completed at least one (1) Cloud Implementation Project with a value at **least LKR 30 million** within the last 5 years prior to the bid submission deadline.
- c) **Average Annual Turnover:** Bidder should have minimum average annual turnover of **LKR 400 Million** within the last 3 years;
- d) Financial Resource: The Bidder must demonstrate access to or availability of financial resources such as liquid assets, line of credit and other financial means, to meet the cash flow requirement of not less than LKR 65 Million, and net of the bidder's other commitments for this project.

A complete set of Procurement Document in English may be purchased from Excise Department of Sri Lanka (EDSL) office (Fourth Floor) by interested bidders on the submission of a written application on a business letterhead, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **LKR 100,000.00.** The method of payment will be by cash.
- 5. Bids must be delivered to the Excise Department, Fourth Floor, No. 353, Kotte Road, Rajagiriya at or before 3.00 p.m. on February 24, 2025. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after the bid closing in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend at 3.00 p.m. on February 24, 2025. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the form of bank guarantee of not less than Sri Lankan Rupees Twelve Million (LKR 12,000,000.00).
- 6. A Pre- Bid Meeting will be held at 10.30 am on February 05, 2025, at Excise Department, 6th Floor Auditorium, No. 353, Kotte Road, Rajagiriya.
